Workshop Description: This workshop is designed to provide participants with effective tools to help children who have been exposed to traumatic events. The course will address the effects of trauma on children and adolescents, provide an overview of current treatment models for trauma, and address ways to help children develop coping skills. The course will use interactive methods to teach play therapy interventions and assessment tools to use with trauma. Case examples will include victims and witnesses of gun violence, kidnapping, assault, and fatal accidents. A prescriptive approach will be used to apply theoretical concepts that provide a basis for treatment.

Workshop Objectives:

1. After the session, participants will be able to name two treatment models for working with children who have experienced trauma.
2. After the session, participants will be able to describe three coping skills that help children deal with trauma.
3. After the session, participants will be able to describe at least three symptoms often seen in children who have experienced trauma.
4. After the session, participants will be able to list three specific play therapy activities to use with children who have experienced trauma.

Presenter: Lisa Staab Shadburn, Psy.D. is the Clinical Director of FrontPoint Child & Family Therapy in South Pasadena and former adjunct faculty member at Alliant International University/CSPP and Phillips Graduate Institute. Dr. Shadburn specializes in play therapy in her clinical practice, and has been conducting trainings and supervision in play therapy and child interventions for over a decade.
